After the park was established in 1926, visitors could access it only through the Selati Railway line. The trains on this line would stop overnight on Selati Railway Bridge. The guests found it amazing to wake up and enjoy the stunning view. In 1973, the railway line was closed because the trains had been running into too many animals. Now, one of the original trains is parked permanently on the bridge and has been converted into a luxury hotel called Kruger Shalati. The hotel has 31 African-style rooms, and each one has floor-to-ceiling windows for admiring the view. The rooms were designed with a combination of old facilities and new decorations. If the hotel owner had not made the unique accommodation, people might have forgotten the trains forever.
